Grammar topic: Making exclamations with “quel”

Curriculum: French Level B1

In French, exclamations are often formed using the interrogative pronoun "quel" (meaning "what" or "which" in English) to express surprise, admiration, or other strong emotions.

Exclamations with "quel" are versatile and can be used in various contexts.

Practice incorporating these structures into your everyday French expressions for added flair and emotion!

Remember to pay attention to the gender and number agreement between "quel" and the noun.

Gender	Singular	Plural
Masculine	Quel + Noun	Quels + Noun
Feminine	Quelle + Noun	Quelles + Noun

- The choice of "quel" depends on the gender and number of the noun it modifies.
- The noun following "quel" must agree in gender and number.

Masculine, Singular	Quel film intéressant!	What an interesting movie!
Masculine, Plural	Quels livres fascinants!	What fascinating books!
Feminine, Singular	Quelle surprise agréable!	What a pleasant surprise!
Feminine, Plural	Quelles chansons magnifiques!	What beautiful songs!

	French	English
Masculine, Singular	Quel homme intelligent!	What an intelligent man!
Masculine, Plural	Quels animaux étonnants!	What amazing animals!
Feminine, Singular	Quelle journée fantastique!	What a fantastic day!
Feminine, Plural	Quelles fleurs magnifiques!	What beautiful flowers!
