# Ways to use this verb

to have food	<p><b>Qu'est-ce que tu prends?</b> What are you having?</p> <p><b>Je prends le poisson.</b> I'm having the fish.</p>
to have drinks	<p><b>Qu'est-ce que tu prends?</b> What are you having?</p> <p><b>Je prends un café.</b> I'm having a coffee.</p>
to get (pick up) something	<p><b>Tu prends le pain?</b> Are you getting the bread?</p> <p><b>Tu prends les chaises?</b> Are you getting the chairs?</p>
to take	<p><b>Je prends la voiture.</b> I'm taking the car.</p> <p><b>Tu prends des notes?</b> Are you taking notes?</p> <p><b>Je prends le temps pour manger.</b> I'm taking the time to eat.</p>

to make an appointment	<p><b>Je prends rendez-vous chez le médecin.</b> I'm making an appointment at the doctor's.</p> <p><b>Tu prends rendez-vous à la banque?</b> Are you making an appointment at the bank?</p>
to make a decision	<p><b>Je vais prendre une décision aujourd'hui.</b> I'm going to make a decision today.</p>

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
