IL Y A is probably the most useful expression in French.

Il y a	There is
Il y a	There are

It doesn't matter if what comes next is singular or plural.
In the present tense, the expression is always IL Y A.

Il y a une abeille sur la fleur.	There is a bee on the flower.
Il y a trois biscuits dans le paquet.	There are three cookies in the package.

IL	It
Y	there (adverbial pronoun Y)
A	3rd person singular
